Advanta Technologies installs *OurLibrary* at Public Defender's Office

The *OurLibrary* system allows the Public Defender's Office to quickly scan, index and store case documents. Any PC in the office can be used to view case files.

Advanta Technologies installed an *OurLibrary* document management system at the Eighth Judicial Circuit, Public Defender's offices in Gainesville, Florida. This system is being used for storage and retrieval of closed cases. This public defender's office closes approximately 1,000 cases each month. Closed case files are often required for appeals and probationary actions.

Two Kodak i260 document scanners were provided by Advanta Technologies. This scanner operates at speeds up to 60 pages per minute. Documents can be scanned, indexed and added to the repository at rates exceeding 800 pages per hour.

The office staff is able to retrieve closed case documents by entering the client name or case number values. Documents can be viewed within a few seconds of each request. Copies of closed case files will be stored on DVD media to minimize any possibility of document loss.
