"I have finally virtually completed the scanning of the STRICOM library. Since October 1, 2002, I have pushed 960,933 images, comprising 4,570 files through the system. We have used 65 CD-RW disks. What was physically left of the library has now become a conference room.

The U.S. Army Program Executive Office for Simulation, Training and Instrumentation, located in Orlando, Florida, purchased the *OurLibrary* document management system with a Kodak document scanner in September, 2002. During the next year, the PEO STRI librarian scanned and indexed documents totaling approximately 1,000,000 pages. These documents represented training manuals and technical documents which filled shelves in several thousand square feet of office space. After these documents were scanned, indexed and stored on hard drive as well as CD media, the paper copies were destroyed and the office space was redeployed.

PEO STRI provides DOCATS, a document catalog system that is available on the Internet. Users, primarily DOD contractors, can search for documents using DOCATS and submit requests for electronic copies. After each user's request has been validated, the librarian will provide an electronic copy via email or using CD media.

In October 2003, Advanta Technologies upgraded the *OurLibrary* software to allow documents to be

converted to Word Searchable PDF files. The PEO STRI library has converted requested documents from the original TIFF format (not searchable) to Word Searchable PDF to provide this useful capability.
